Description

Antique 1919 silver pocket watch. The watch has a Swiss stem-winding movement which is working nicely. The watch is bigger than a standard 50mm pocket watch at 56mm diameter excluding the winding stem and the loop. The case has a screw-on bezel and case back... usually this model is seen in nickel but this particular watch has a silver case. The inner case back is hallmarked for London (import mark) 1919 with an importer's mark for George Stockwell. From 1 June 1907, Stockwells acted as assay agents, facilitating the import into Britain of foreign gold and silver items, which had to be assayed and hallmarked in a UK assay office before being released for retail. The case has the odd mark and a couple of shallow indentations to the back but overall the condition is good. The acrylic lens is in good condition. The dial is a replacement although it is antique. The watch comes in a new presentation box.
