Frederick William Jackson (1859–1918) was born at Oldham in 1859. He was the son of an art dealer and photographer and was a member of the Arts Club in 1879, the Limners Club in 1880 and the Manchester Academy of Fine Arts in 1881. He was a founder member of the Staithes group and Art Club and exhibited widely throughout the country. His work is now in important private and public collections and is much sought after. "The Bridge at Ludlow" is a quality large oil on canvas by Jackson. The painting measures 28"x 36" and is signed lower left. It is framed in a hand made frame giving an overall size of 36"x 44".
