The lid opens and is supported by two stays and has a good quality working brass lock with key. The base section having a superb solid ebony carved serpentine shaped frieze and the whole supported on fantastic carved cabriole legs with beautiful caryatid heads and shaped feet. Ebony (Diospyros ebenum) is a species of ebony that is found throughout the flat dry country of the east and southeast coastal regions of Ceylon (Sri Lanka).
