Description

Rare early nineteenth century rosewood wheel barometer of diminutive proportions by F. Amadio & Son, St John St Road, London with a 4 1/2" (11.5cm) diameter silvered register, thermometer, hygrometer and level; the case inlaid with brass double-line stringing and a cut-brass scrollwork motif, surmounted by a swan's neck pediment. Circa 1830 Francis Amadio (Snr & Jnr) were in partnership at 118 St John Street Road from c 1805 to 1840 and were noted for high quality barometers. John Beazor Antiques is a family firm, established in 1875 and based in Cambridge since 1940. We are a traditional antiques shop, but very much in the 21st century. We deal in 18th and early 19th century furniture, barometers and clocks. We choose our stock for its originality and for the quality of its colour, patination and design. We are members of the BADA.
