This exceptional china cabinet / vitrine has been sympathetically restored, it retains its original finish, colour and patina, all in wonderful condition throughout. Ready to place go straight into the home, splits into two sections for ease of installation. Dimensions: Width 95cms Depth 52cms Height 213cms Edwards & Roberts was founded in 1845, and had premises at 21 Wardour Street London. By 1892 they occupied more than a dozen buildings in Wardour Street, where they continued to trade until the end of the century. They became one of the leading London cabinet makers and retailers working in a variety of styles, both modern and revivalist. Their business also involved retailing, adapting and restoring the finest antique furniture and there are many examples of their earlier furniture with later emb...
