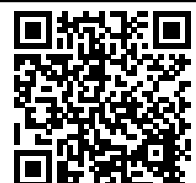

The glass has a star cut base and of course this entire thing wouldn't be filled with ink, just the small removable glass liner which sits under the hinged lid, (there are a couple of nibbles to the liner, mentioned purely for accuracy). The pierced or reticulated silver mount is quite exceptional, to be expected by such a silversmith and all without damage. A real beauty measuring 4" tall x 4" in diameter.
