Description

Pair of unusual Samson of Paris porcelain vases, c. 1880. Both square shaped, waisted vases, painted in Japanese Edo Period Imari style, with shaped panels of pavilions before rivers, and jardinieres of flowering plants. All upon a cobalt blue ground, heightened with gilt floral scrollwork. Unglazed base. These vases would have been made to replace damaged vases from a garniture of original Japanese Imari vases dating from the late 17th Century. Height - 30 cm, 11 7/8". Width - 13 cm, 5 1/8". Depth - 13 cm, 5 1/8". Condition - Typical minor wear to the gilding. No damage. No restoration.
