The ebony-mounted moulded cornice with gilded brass rose 'boss' mounts , surmounted with a well-executed simulated or painted green faux marble 'slab' , with refreshed finish . The doors fitted with a lock and working key , separated by a reeded brass dividing strip , enclosing an interior with 3 adjustable shelves . The base with an applied moulding raised on compressed turned bun feet . Original panelled back-boards . A decorative bookcase of practical scale and elegant proportions.
