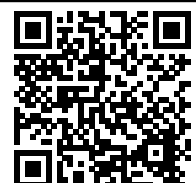
No: 10897 A superb and rare mid 19th. century Amboyna and Bone Inlaid Davenport by J & T Scott of 10 George Street, Edinburgh stamped on both the carcass and lock, with hinged leathered writing surface revealing a satinwood interior of small drawers. The top with a hinged compartment with small lidded fitments and ink wells; the panelled body with a hinged side door enclosing graduated drawers with recessed wooden pulls; standing on ring turned bun feet with concealed under casters. J & T Scott were cabinet makers and upholsterers who worked out of impressive premises at 10 George Street, Edinburgh from the middle of the 19th century. The company was still trading well into the beginning of the 20th century and, throughout its years of manufacturing high quality furniture, was held in high esteem by notable institutions and nobility alike. International exhibitions included the Great Exhibition of 1862 in London and the International Industrial Exhibition, Edinburgh, in 1886. Amongst their principal clients were the Royal Society of Edinburgh, The Scottish National Portrait Gallery, for w...
