He is standing in a ready position showing his bare upper torso with muscles flexed for the next swing of the enormous hammer. Good original condition with a mid-brown patina. Signed V Demanet on the base. Victor Demanet (1895 - 1964) was born in Belgium. Demanet studied fine art before serving in the army. Inspired by a visit to Paris in 1921, he resumed working in sculpture. He produced large scale sculpture, medals and worked for public and private patrons and exhibited internationally.
