Blued steel hands with date and seconds. An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. Quality feature of brass cased weights. Henry Hawkins of Plymouth is recorded in Ponsford's 'Devon Clockmakers and Watchmakers' book as working in 1798.
