A well engraved seconds dial and date aperture with blued steel hands. An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. Thomas Follit of Lichfield is recorded in Mc Kenna's 'Clockmakers and Watchmakers of Central England' book as working from 1750-1773.
