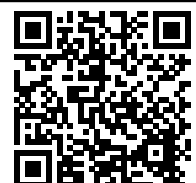
Fine William IV period rosewood pedestal table; the circular hinged top with finely figured paired veneers and a convex segmental apron; on a bold baluster stem and a triangular platform base with unusual and voluptuously carved decoration.
