A fine turtle stone/Septarian Nodule marble topped occasional table with a highly decorative cast iron tripod base. The rare marble top shows the amazing geological formation of septarian nodules formed millions of years ago which was cut, polished and inset into small decorative highly prized pieces of furniture after being discovered in Oxfordshire in the 19th century. The cast iron tripod base of the table has intricately worked trefoil pillar with lattice work decoration terminating in downswept scrolling feet. It bears no registration marks but is very much in the Coalbrookdale style. The combination of the cast iron and stunning marble compliment each other and make a wonderful decorative but practical table for inside or out.
