A very important painting by this internationally acclaimed portrait artist of royalty and aristocracy. Sir Max Muspratt, 1st Baronet (3 February 1872 – 20 April 1934) was a British chemist and a politician in the city of Liverpool. He was born at Seaforth Hall, Liverpool, the son of Edmund Knowles Muspratt and his wife Frances. The Muspratt family was originally from Dublin but moved to Liverpool in 1822 when James Muspratt, the father of Edmund, established a chemical factory in Vauxhall Road. Max was educated at a private school in Hemel Hempstead and at Clifton College, Bristol, before studying industrial chemistry at Zürich Polytechnic. He joined the United Alkali Company in 1892 (the firm had been founded by his father), becoming a director in 1901 and its chairman from 1914. In 1926 the Un...
