Description

A very nice large early 19th century Derby sucrier and cover, bombe shape set on four bun feet with twisted side handles and stepped shaped cover with a rectangular fluted knob. Ornatly decorated in gilt on a plain white ground, each side features a large reserve finely painted with named landscapes, probably by John Brewer. Similarly themed scenes, one titled "Near Reading, Berkshire" depicts 3 men in a canoe on a river with a fine hilly landscape and a castle stood atop a cliff, and the other titled "Wales" showing another castle set up on a hillside with a river running along the bottom and a couple standing on the other river bank surrounded by trees with a mountain in the distance. The views in red script to the base along with the red painted factory mark c.1815. It measures 17.8cm (7") wide, 12.8cm (5") deep and 13.3cm (5 1/4") high. Condition is very good overall but there are a few hairlines, mainly minor but with a longer one to the cover running from under the knob to the rim. There is one other short line approx. 1" from the rim to the first step on the cover and 2 other very short ones a few millimeters. There are 5 very short hairlines to the rim of the ...
