Description

Stunning blue & white English pottery plate of exhibition quality made by Wileman & Co circa 1891 (who are the makers of both Shelley & Foley, which explains why this plate came from a private collection of Shelley China). 24.3cm diameter. Foliate form with beaded ribs & fine pattern including flower rosette, ribbon garlands and diamond frames, gilded edge (Recorded as the shell pattern on 24th May 1890). Plate impress marked with number Rd 150035 for 1890 & the painted design numbered Rd 164516 for 1891. As shown in the pictures. Small hairline crack to rear glaze above & to left of the England emblem & a smaller than pinhead chip to one of the scallop ribs on the front but is exactly as shown in the photographs.

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
