The lower section having a serpentine marble top and a mahogany lined frieze drawer with two swept mahogany arms for umbrellas which are raised on fine acanthus carved cabriole supports. Having turned column end supports and removable drip trays to the serpentine base, the whole supported on turned bun feet.
