Each drawer is dressed with recessed brass handles. Splits into three parts for ease of transport. Believed to have belonged to Captain James Neish. Inside is a note that reads; 'Captain's Sea Chest. Captain James Neish. Died 1866. Probably "The Fort William", Dundee, Scotland.' Item Ref; M-763 .
