Width...19.5"/49.5cm. Depth...15.5"/ 39.5cm. Delivery to most of U.K. mainland £45. NOTE. Richard Bridgens was an apprentice to the renowned cabinet maker George Bullock. When George Bullock died in 1818, Bridgens started his own business and produced some extraordinary pieces and was considered ahead of his time for both his designs and furniture making.
