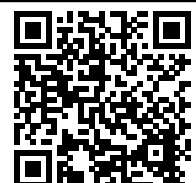

A quality 5 pillar mechanism of 8-day duration with brass cased weights and flat brass rod pendulum as seen on finer clocks.
