Chinese silver globular flask, Luen Wo, Shanghai, c. 1900. The heavy gauge silver flask, being cast and chased with flowering cherry blossom. The twin handles formed as large branches of the prunus tree, at the neck of the flask, all upon an engraved 'Cracked Ice' ground. Luen Wo Hall marks to the base. Weight - 356 grammes, 12 1/2oz. Height - 15.2 cm, 6". Diameter - 11.5 cm, 4 1/2". Condition - Excellent. No damage. No repair.
