Description

WW2 Vulcain Air Ministry Observer's pocket watch, 1940. The watch has a good quality 15-jewel stem-winding movement, reference 725, which is working nicely. The movement is signed with the Vulcain name. The origins of Vulcain date back to 1858 when Maurice Ditisheim, a Swiss manufacturer, began producing pocket watches under the name Ditisheim. The name Vulcain was first seen in 1894 and was officially registered by the Ditisheim family in 1900. The movement is protected by an inner hinged cover which is inscribed, 'Vulcain fabrique de montre de précision fondée en 1858 Médailles aux expositions universelles Paris 1889, Chicago 1893 La plus haute récompense Observatoire de Neuchatel Suisse prix de série pour les six meilleurs chronomètres Exposition internationale Barcelone 1929 Grand Prix' which translates as...
