A lovely original single blued steel hand with quarter hour dial markers. A lyre shaped steel and brass single train mechanism of unusual design with anchor escapement and the original small lead weight. Circa 1710. The clock came from a private collection and has survived in remarkably original condition. Early quaker clocks turn up infrequently and are often unsigned. Most were made in the Oxfordshire area.
