Of generous proportions, offering large display space. Of bow fronted form with a pair of glazed doors over a pair of cupboard doors. All doors are lockable (key supplied) and open to reveal shelving behind. The cabinet is decorated with inlaid floral motifs and harebells as well as ebony stringing throughout and cross banding to the cupboard doors. All standing on turned legs united by an under-tier. Offered for sale in excellent original condition ready to go straight into the home. Splits into 2 sections for ease of installation. Dimensions: Width 132cms Depth 49cms Height 223cms Maple & Co was established by John Maple, a shopkeeper from Horley, Surrey, who later opened a furniture shop in Tottenham Court Road. However it was his son, John Blundell Maple, who made Maples & Co a success. With exceptional business skills, John B. Maple took over the company while still a young man. By the 1880s they were the largest furniture store in the world, exported their fine furniture ...
