A 19th century high-back ash and elm Windsor armchair, circa 1840, the hoop back with central pierced double splat over a shaped seat raised on turned supports joined by a crinoline stretcher. This design is typical of chairs made at the workshop of George Nicholson and Fred Walker in the village of Rockley, Nottinghamshire. The back 99cm high, the seat 48cm wide, 38cm deep and 40cm high.
