A very fine William and Mary solid walnut stool, original frame, with well turned legs conjoined by a lovely turned H form stretcher. Made by a skilled hand, peg jointed throughout and dating from c.1690. . The deeply padded seat has been professionally re-upholstered in a high quality thick velvet with a beautiful pomegranate and madder leaf pattern - a William Morris design for which he took inspiration from 17th century and earlier tapestries and furnishings. The upholstery finished with a trim of bead and pomegranate tassels all very much in keeping with fashionable fabrics of the William and Mary period. . The stool is heavy and structurally sound throughout with no later elements and the walnut has developed an excellent rich colour and patination. . An eye catching and high quality late 17th century stool of most attractive proportion and design, robust enough for daily use. . A charming and rare survivor. . .
