An attractive early 19th. Century Dutch marquetry burr walnut cabinet on chest. The cabinet section having a broken arch pediment above the chequered frieze. The single inlaid door having arched astragal glazing bars and flanked by canted glazed sides. The door opens via lock & key to reveal shaped display shelves. The chest section having a wonderful shaped top with floral marquetry inlay of scrolling foliage, birds, tulips, butterflies and vase in boxwood and fruitwood against a burr walnut background. The 3 serpentine shaped drawers having further marquetry and retaining all the original brass handles and escutcheons. The marquetry stiles of Bombe form and terminating in turned bun feet. The ends inlaid with a fisherman and a woman carrying 2 baskets of fish. This attractive piece of early 19th. Century Dutch furniture has solid oak linings throughout and is in good original condition with the usual signs of wear associated with age and use. Dimensions:- Max.Height...68"/ 173cm.
