Rare early 19th century mahogany metamorphic library steps stool, the folding treads contained within a substantial frame with turned legs and supports; the seat covered in brown striped fabric. Circa 1830 34 ¾" (88cm) wide, 19" (48cm) deep and (closed) 22" (56cm) high, maximum (open) height is 47 1/2" (120.5cm), tread height 10 ½" (26.5cm).
