An oak case with mahogany crossbanding and original brass key escutcheon plate. An attractive square painted dial with original gold leaf corners and floral decorations. A date aperture and seconds dial. An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. The Tyte family of Wells are well documented in A J Moores' 'The Clockmakers of Somerset' book as working from 1815. Cornelius worked at 3, Sadler Street and his son continued the business until 1887. Height 6ft 5 " / 195 cms Width (at widest point) 18 " / 46 cms Depth 9 1/2 " / 25 cms.
