Description

Joseph D'Aste A c1915 French green and brown patinated cast bronze of a Pair of Doves, signed with 'Salon des Beaux Arts' Height 31 cm and Width 64 cm Joseph D'Aste (1881-1945), is a sculptor of Italian birth born in Naples, who mainly worked in France, more precisely in Paris. Joseph d'Asté moved to Paris around 1900 and exhibited at the Salon of French artists from 1905. His sculpted groups, which often represent children, mostly imagine representations of children and scenes from rural and popular life. One of these groups, Peasants and Children, produced between 1850 and 1909, appears in the collections of the Musée de Orsay. Joseph d'Asté was active until 1935.

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
