The silver top, which fits nicely, is beautifully embossed with flora and trellis design and the underneath is a lovely lemony yellow gilt finish. Hallmarks are visible on the lid for the Birmingham Assay office with a date mark for 1904 and Lion Passant indicating sterling silver. The maker's mark is also visible for the silver maker: Levi & Salaman. A lovely jar and a good heavy weight in great antique condition with no chips to the cut glass or dents to the silver.
