Leda holds the swan in her arms with his wing wrapped around her. The side pieces are tazzas with stems supported by swans. It is finely modelled in patinated white metal. A beautiful red and orange specimen marble is used for the bases along with a contrasting white veined marble. The dial is crisp white porcelain enamel with its original blued steel hands and convex glass. The dial is signed for the retailer, Chevauchee, Clermont-Ferrand. The French movement is of high quality and is in excellent clean and running condition having been fully overhauled by our clockmaker. Pendulum is original. It runs for 8 days and strikes the hours and halves on a bell. We have a video available of the clock running, please ask. Condition of the case is very good, the original finish has some rubbing, loss, discoloration and tarnish. The marble is also very good with some small nibbles to the corners and edges. The marble of the bottom of the case has an old repair. Signature of the artist P Segal t...
