A very attractive Edwardian solid silver envelope style stamp case. Beautifully engraved and unusual as the case has a button fastening rarely seen (the envelope flap closes onto a button that fits in place on the flap - see images). The engraving on the back of the case has an unusually designed empty cartouch, above which are the hallmarks for the Birmingham Assay Office with a date mark for 1902 and Lion Passant indicating sterling silver. The maker's mark for Henry Williamson is also visible. Condition: In great antique condition (the hallmarks are slightly rubbed, however, still visible). Hallmarks and maker's marks: Birmingham 1902 by Henry Williamson Ltd. Measurements: Height: 2.4 cm Width: 2.8 cm Weight: 5.8 grams Weights and measurements are approximate.
