In a wonderfully warm oak with good original patina, it features a triple panelled fascia over a strap work carved frieze, with an attractively carved lozenge to the central front panel. Construction/Wood: Oak Condition Report: Wear and marks commensurate with age. Some typical old repairs to the lid – some gaps run along top of lid where a piece of wood has been let in. Solid and sturdy. Back leg has been replaced at some point. Old replacement hinges. Lock not original.
