The craftsmanship is outstanding and the weight substantial (7.1 troy ozs). The condition is very good, there is one minute dent to one of the salts, clearly shown in the photographs and not detrimental to the function or appearance. The salts have a small, lightly engraved crest, lion rampant with initials below.
