The flask is marked to the bottom with 1/4 pt so holds 1/4 pint (4 3/4 fl oz. 140 ml). A high quality item that feels wonderful in the hand and would make a stunning sporting gift. Hallmark: Fully hallmarked with Lion for sterling silver. Crown for Sheffield. Date letter W for 1939. Makers mark J.D & S for James Dixon & Sons. Also hallmarked to the top and hinge with Lion for sterling silver. Weight: 182 grams.
