Fine George III period mahogany bracket-clock of particularly nice size; the eight-day striking movement with a finely engraved backplate and a 7" (17.5cm) domed and silvered dial inscribed C. A. CANTI, TOWN MALLING. In a richly coloured triple-pad break-arch case with two cast scrollwork spandrels, scale side-frets and ogee feet. Circa 1815 *C. A. Canti is recorded principally as a barometer-maker working in Town Mall (Kent) from circa 1815 - 1845 and later at various addresses in London. 10 1/2" (26.5cm) wide, 7" (17.5cm) deep and 13 1/2" (34cm) high (15"/38cm with extended handle) John Beazor Antiques is a family firm, established in 1875 and based in Cambridge since 1940.
