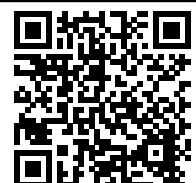

There is a good clear hallmark to the front for the highly collectible Chester assay office and the date 1909. The makers mark for A.E. Jones; Albert E. Jones (1870-1954) studied at the Central school of Arts and Crafts in Birmingham under Edward Taylor and later worked as a Guildman at the Birmingham Guild of Handicrafts.
