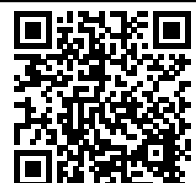
Description

French Napoleonic Naval Dagger c.1810 This is a French Napoleonic Naval Dagger from c.1810. The dagger has a unusual wood turned conical grip with near the top a bronze ring and on the pommel a brass flower shaped ornament. The very ornate half moon bronze hilt is decorated with the head of the emperor with laurel leaves in a medallion and crowned with the Napoleonic Imperial eagle and flanked by armouries and two lion heads. The blade is fully engraved but due to ageing hard to see. The leather & brass scabbard is missing it's brass sheath mouth. Overall measurement: Length 46cm - Length of the blade: 29.5cm
