A fine Edwardian walking cane/stick made of partridge wood with a curved tortoiseshell handle and silver collar hallmarked for London 1909 with makers mark ED. The stick also has a smooth horn tip. The silver collar has a chased design and an armorial shield with monogram CD. The silver collar also bears the name Sangster in tiny initials - W&J Sangster were renowned London stick and umbrella makers at the time. The stick is in overall excellent condition.
