THIS ADDRESS IS NO LONGER EXTANT THANKS TO THE ENDEAVOURS OF THE LUFTWAFFE BUT No 12 WAS AND STILL WOULD BE THESE DAYS, PART OF THE MOST LUXURIOUS AREA OF BELGRAVIA. SEVERAL DRAWERS ARE STAMPED WITH REDWOODS MARK. THIS BEAUTIFUL LITTLE CABINET COULD BE USED FOR MANY PURPOSES, IT IS MADE WITH LUSTROUS AND WELL FIGURED HONDURAS MAHOGANY AND HAS THE ORIGINAL FITTED BRASS FLIP UP CARRYING HANDLE TO THE TOP, MORE FAMILIAR IN PERIOD GUN CASES OF THE TIME. THIS CABINET MAY WELL HAVE BEEN USED AS AN ACCESSORY CASE FOR A GUN OWNER OF THE DAY OR SUPPLIED BY A GUNSMITH FOR THAT PURPOSE. SIX WELL MADE DRAWERS BEHIND TWO PANELLED DOORS WITH SHOOT BOLTS, LOCK AND KEY AND ORIGINAL HINGES. HEIGHT. 16.75 INCHES. WIDTH. 18.75 INCHES. FRONT TO BACK. 7.25 INCHES. A BEAUTIFUL PERIOD PIECE.
