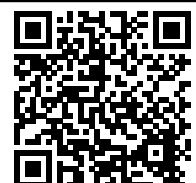
Description

An Antique Indian silver pedestal rose bowl, circa 1880, probably made in Lucknow, India, with repousse and chased decoration of a hunting scene. The continuous landscape scene features figures with guns in a howdah riding on the back of an elephant, other figures on horseback with bows and arrows and hunters with hounds on foot hunting tigers, boar and deer, within a landscape with palm trees. One side with an initialled cartouche within multiple beaded borders, lappets to the bottom section and raised on a pedestal foot with lappet decoration. 17cm high x 21cm diam. 698 grammes. Condition: The bottom rim of the foot is folded under and there are multiple pinprick polishing holes on the repousse high points.
