There is a little damage to the silver rim on the jug, around the pouring spout, which can be seen in the photographs. The spoon is clearly hallmarked with the maker's name of William Suckling Ltd and is decorated with a foliate design on a shaped handle. The glass is in excellent condition, faceted and clear, with the starburst base which is always a sign of quality.
