Neresheimer & Sohne who worked in Hanau, Germany and was imported by Berthold Mueller. It's also has the 925 silver purity mark and the I mark of Chester 1909 so it was imported and assayed there at that time. It has some unusual scenes depicted all round, the top shows a tavern scene with people drinking and dancing and around the sides it shows fishing scenes.
