Description

The original gilded case showing memorial trophies and motifs under the dial. Roman dial, the twin drum movement with outside countwheel striking on a bell on the hours and half hours. The dial and the movement is signed by the maker. "Louis-Constantin Detouche". Circa 1860. Louis-Constantin Detouche ran the watchmaking business of his father, Georges Detouche. In 1830, he moved to 158-160 rue Saint-Martin and specialized in precision clocks, scientific instruments such as regulators, and jewelry. Having acquired land in Villemomble, he became mayor of this commune. He is buried in the old cemetery of Villemomble". Weight 6 kg.
