Description

A very good quality late Victorian figured mahogany lancet top mantel clock with boxwood stringing to the front of the case stood on brass ball feet. The clock has a silvered dial with a slow-fast mechanism and has a German Winterhalder & Hofmeier eight day ting tang movement which strikes the quarters, half hours and hours on two gongs. The clock movement is stamped on the back plate with the makers name:- W&H Winterhalder & Hofmeier were considered the finest clockmakers in the Victorian era, they came from a family of clockmakers. They were based Germany's Black Forest region. The company was established in 1810 by Thomas Winterhalder, and was continued by his three sons Matthäus, Karl and Linus. Thomas' son Matthaues took over in 1830 and in 1850 Anton Hofmeier joined the company, who was himself a clockmaker and relative to the Winterhalder family. The company then became known as Winterhalder and Hofmeier. The clock movement has been cleaned and serviced and comes with a 12 month guarantee.
