Description

An early 18th century three panel carved oak coffer, circa 1700, the front with a geometric carved frieze over three geometric and flowerhead carved panels, with original iron lock, the interior with pine candlebox and drawer to one side, the lid lined in 19th century cotton fabric. Previously the property of Sir Horace James Seymour GCMG CVO (1885 – 1978), British diplomat, Ambassador of the United Kingdom to Iran from 1936 - 1939 and China from 1942 - 1946. He was the great-grandson of Robert Ellice and Eliza Courtney, the illegitimate daughter of Georgiana, Duchess of Devonshire. He lived at Bratton House in Westbury, Wiltshire. This dresser was removed from Bratton House on his death and has until recently remained in the Seymour family by descent.
