The stout lid is dressed with an engraved brass plate and reads '1918 N.14. 199'. Secured by way of long iron clasp, the lid opens to reveal rich caramel hues. Lid interior stamped with the crown mark 'A.M. 1936'. Opens smoothly on long sliding hinge arm. AM painted in cursive stencil to the front fascia. Hand-painted 195 in cream is an eye-catching touch. Trunk interior features a selection of trays for tools or personal effects. Dressed with a pair of iron drop handles with broad keepers. This is a charming antique farrier's chest, with a set of storage trays inside and appealing detail to the dark finish.
