A delightfully shaped solid silver Trinket Box. This Box is an oval scalloped shape which is exceptionally pretty. It is a plain polished silver with no engraving or embossing and stands on four neat scroll feet. The hinged lid opens to reveal a lovely gilt interior to the underneath of the lid and a pale green velvet lining. Clear and crisp hallmarks are visible on the underneath for the Birmingham Assay office with a date mark for 1920 and Lion Passant indicating fine sterling silver. The maker's mark is also visible for the silver maker William Henry Sparrow. Partial marks can also be seen on the interior of the lid. A beautiful item elegantly and unusually designed. Condition: In great antique condition with no dents or marks to the silver (the position of one of the feet seems to step in minutely, however, this does not affect the overall appearance of the item and does not affect the balance as it stands perfectly flat on its feet). Hallmarks: Birmingham 1920 by William Henry Sparrow. Measurements: Height: 5.5 cm Width: 9.8 cm Depth: 6.4 cm Weight: 104 grams Weights and measurements are approximate.
